SPLINE UP or SPLINE DOWN?

SPLINE UP =

When the screen is made oriented as ordered, the spline groove will be visible.

SPLINE DOWN =

When the screen is made oriented as ordered, the spline groove will NOT be visible.

And you want installation to be SPLINE TOWARDS YOU, then order...	↑ <i>SPLINE UP</i>	<i>SPLINE DOWN</i> ↓	↑ <i>SPLINE UP</i>	<i>SPLINE DOWN</i> ↓
And you want installation to be SPLINE AWAY FROM YOU, then order...	<i>SPLINE DOWN</i> ↓	↑ <i>SPLINE UP</i>	<i>SPLINE DOWN</i> ↓	↑ <i>SPLINE UP</i>

We suggest installation SPLINE AWAY FROM YOU which makes it easier to hold the frame when pulling the mesh tight during installation with screws, and it often produces a more cleanly finished look for the installed job.

Georgia Screen Products produces Screens either SPLINE UP or SPLINE DOWN for the same price. If no preference is specified, we will suggest SPLINE DOWN.

Screens that are symmetric along at least one axis can be flipped between SPLINE UP and SPLINE DOWN simply by rotating the Screen around the axis of symmetry.

Screens with no axis of symmetry (angular shapes and nearly rectangular shapes with different top-bottom and left-right measures) CANNOT be flipped between SPLINE UP and SPLINE DOWN without remaking the entire Screen.
